JUDGING

- Appearance neatness, materials used & overall workmanship 33 points
- Authenticity scale, effective use of the practice listed on tray 33 points
- Conservation practices effectively using a MINIMUM of three 33 points
- Practices must be evident to the viewer and neatly labeled





- All entries must be identified on the side of the tray with the following information:
 - Individual or group name
 - 4-H Club or FFA/FCCLA Chapter
 - Age
 - Division

(Junior, Intermediate, Senior or Group)

- Must use a 20" x 26" x 6" plastic tray.

- Borrowed trays will require a deposit of \$20.00
